Admission Requirements

1. Graduate degree in Nursing (MSN or DNP) with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
2. Hold a current registered nurse license from the California Board of Registered Nursing (BRN), unencumbered, unrestricted, with no disciplinary action pending or imposed.
3. One-year full time clinical experience working as an RN.
4. GRE is NOT required.
