Added Authorizations and Certificate Options

Added Authorization

Students in the M.A. in Education - C&I program have the option of earning an Added Authorization, Reading & Literacy certification through the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) by taking all 12 units of literacy elective courses and having three years of credentialed teaching experience. These courses also count as electives in the program, and students have the option of completing one or more literacy courses to fulfill elective requirements without earning the certificate.

Introductory Computer Science Supplemental Authorizations

These courses also count as electives in the program. Students must apply to the Computer Science Supplemental Authorization and request courses to fulfill C&I elective requirements.
