<sup>1</sup> Three additional three semester-unit courses in Theatre, at least two of which must be upper division, selected with the approval of the faculty advisor. Note: 1000 level courses may not be used to satisfy this requirement.

<sup>2</sup> Depending on the student's class level. These courses can be repeated for credit. Each student must complete at least four of these courses, two at the upper-division level.

<sup>3</sup> Production courses can be repeated for credit. Of the seven, (i) two courses must be selected from THTR 2460 Technical Theatre Laboratory and THTR 4460 Technical Theatre Laboratory, (ii) two courses must be selected from THTR 2470 Run of Show and THTR 4470 Run of Show, or one from THTR 2470 Run of Show and THTR 4470 Run of Show and one from THTR 2480 Stage Management Practicum and THTR 4480 Stage Management Practicum, and (iii) four must be taken for upper-division credit.

A minor in another discipline is recommended, though not required.
